

**ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984
WEST BERKSHIRE DISTRICT COUNCIL
(BYWAYS OPEN TO ALL TRAFFIC IN THE PARISHES OF
BUCKLEBURY AND LAMBOURN)
(TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF MECHANICALLY PROPELLED
VEHICLES) ORDER 2022**

West Berkshire District Council has **made** an Order in accordance with Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be to prohibit any mechanically propelled vehicle with 3 wheels or more from proceeding in any direction over the byways listed in Schedule 1 **WHICH INCLUDES THE BYWAY ON WHICH THIS NOTICE IS EXHIBITED.**

An alternative route for all vehicles affected by the Order can be found by using local roads.

The purpose of this Order is to preserve the surface of the byways during winter months.

The Order will come into effect on Monday 24th October 2022 and will remain in force until Monday 24th April 2023.

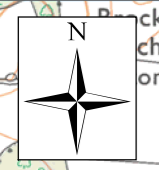

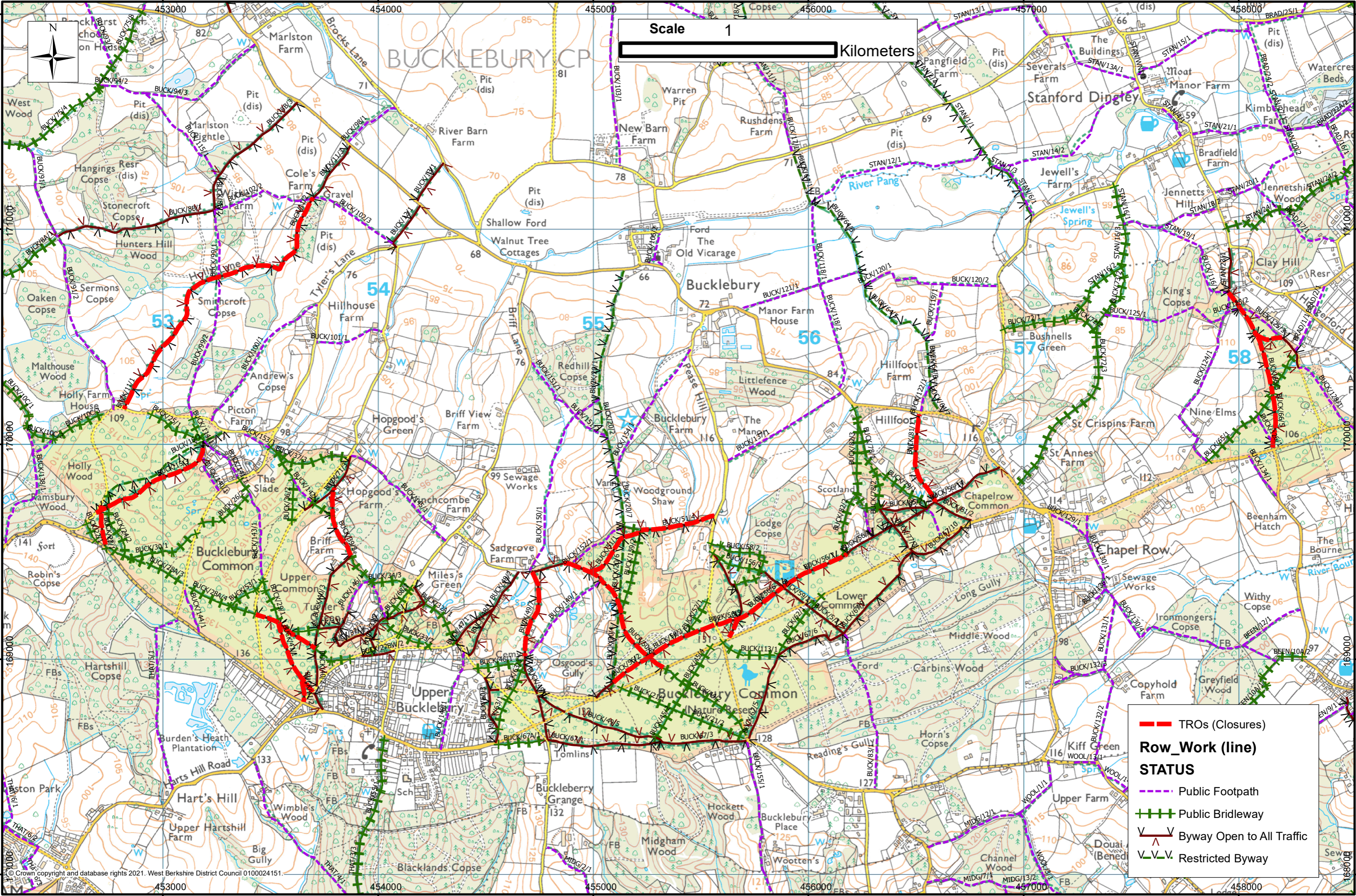

Bucklebury Byways Open to All Traffic: Temporary Traffic Regulation Order (24th October 2022 to 24th April 2023)

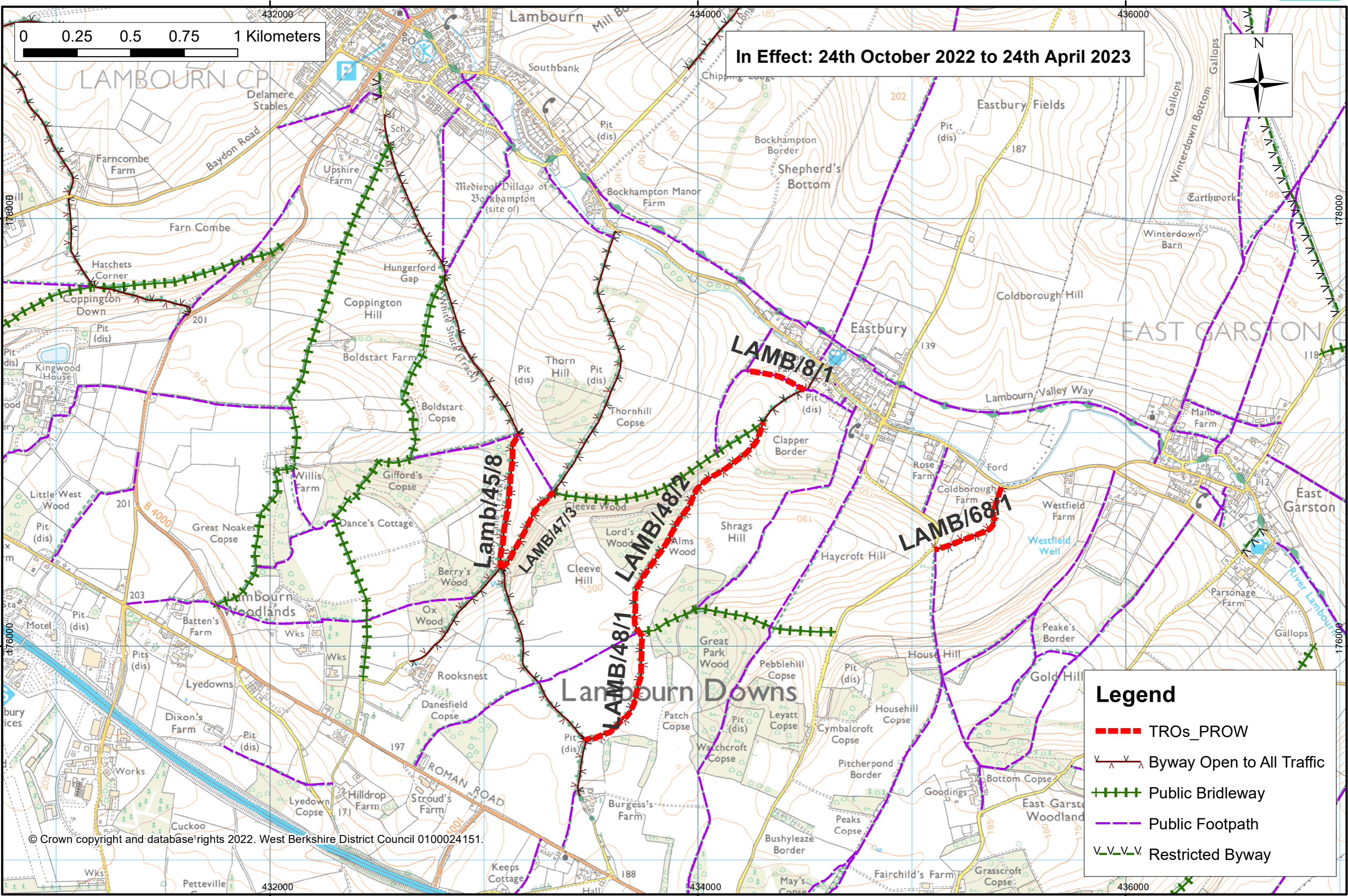


Scale 1 Kilometers
