I am writing in opposition of the planned development in North East Thatcham.

As a resident of Upper Bucklebury and Chapel Row , I foresee a safety risk in the volume of traffic that would be generated along the Avenue and Hatch lane.

Already traffic is heavier in this area. With the proposed extra houses would come commuters seeking a route to the A4, through an area with no footpaths or lampposts. When children are walking to their school buses that park opposite the Bladebonr, I can see danger and a child being seriously injured by a rushing commuter in a car.

With other brownfield sites available to develop , I don't think greensite is the option the council should support.
